Love Where You Live Sacred Ground

Text: Mark 4:35; 5:2-8; 18-20; Matthew 14:14

Purpose: We can't always choose who our neighbor is and since we believe God is working in people's lives through us, we see ourselves placed by God for a purpose to the people around us.

Opening Question: What makes a good neighbor?

Read and Discuss: Mark 4:35; 5:2-8; 18-20; Matthew 14:14

- 1. How are your neighbors different from you? What ways can it be difficult to connect with them?
- 2. What do you think the disciples thought when they entered the Decapolis, and a demonized man came running toward them?
- 3. What kinds of things would you like to see God do for your neighbors?
- 4. How has God wired you to be an influencer?
 - a. Storyteller: Sharing the ways God has personally helped you.
 - b. Connector: Ability to connect and make new friends right away.
 - c. Grace Giver: Able to see what people can become.
 - d. Intercessor: Faithfully pray for neighbors over the years.
 - e. Caretaker: Practically provide for people's needs.
- 5. Jesus comes back to Decapolis in Matthew 14 and now lots of people know about Him. What would be your hope for your neighbors 5 years from now? 10 years from now? What would you like to see God do for them?
