2. *How does asking God for “daily bread” lead us into a more peaceful and joyful life? What strategies have you found helpful to live content?*
3. *In Luke 13 what mistake did the rich man make? If the rich man asked God why he had so much, what do you think God might say to him?*
4. *In Proverbs 21 how are the wise wealthy? How can saving be challenging? What changes can you make to save more?*
5. *If in debt, what is one step you can make to gain traction toward financial freedom? What could cause you to slip into debt?*
