- 3. vs. 10-11 Describe some of the "schemes" or strategies Satan uses to get us to fall?

Read and Discuss: Ephesians 6:14-20

- 4. Which part of the armor of God is most important to you?
- 5. What does it mean for us that we are to "put on" and "take up" the armor of God? How do you know when you are not putting on or taking up the armor of God given to us?
- 6. What does Paul mean when he says we should "pray at all times in the Spirit"? What could distract you from staying focused on God?
- 7. How does speaking the truth about God to God and ourselves help us stand firm?
